He was born in Warren, OH on 10/02/1954 and lived his childhood in Cortland, OH with his parents John and Joan and siblings, Steve, Larry, Jeff and Arlene. He joined Delta Air Lines at age 18 and worked in Cleveland, Chicago, Salt Lake City and Phoenix AZ for 33 years as an agent until his retirement. He is survived by his wife, Emese, daughter, Ashley, mother Joan, sister Arlene, brothers Steve and Larry, grandchildren, Cadence, Clarissa, Noah.

He was the best husband, father, grandfather and son anyone could have. He loved his family and adored his daughter.
