MARY KIM KAMAKAALOHA LUM HO, 62, of Hilo, Hawai'i, passed away on January 9, 2026.

She was born on April 27, 1963, in Hilo. Mary Kim retired as the Athletic Director of Haili Christian School after a lifetime of dedicated service to her community.

She was the eldest of seven children born to Albert Sr. "Itchi" and Leone Lum Ho. She is survived by her brothers, Albert Jr. "Peka," Talbert, and Alston Maluo (Camille); her sisters, Gerry Lee Hicks and Sue Lynn (Alan) Nakamura; as well as numerous uncles, aunts, cousins, nephews, and nieces.

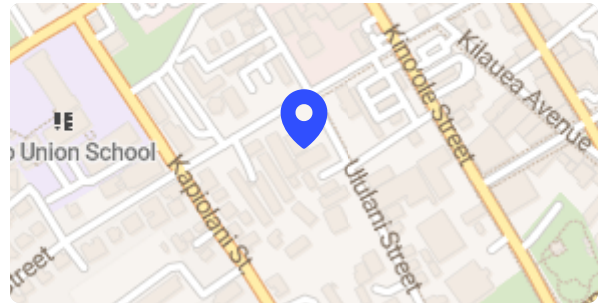
